**ANNOUNCEMENT FOR INVITATION TO BIDDERS**  
**Bids For The**  
**“Expansion of Deir Nbouh & Deir Amar Substations”**

1. The Council for Development and Reconstruction (CDR), on behalf of the Ministry of Energy and Water (MEW) of the Republic of Lebanon, invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the ***“Expansion of Deir Nbouh & Deir Amar Substation”*** Project.
2. The Government of Lebanon received a loan from the Arab Fund for Economic and Social Development (AFESD) and intends to apply a part of the proceeds of this loan to eligible payments under the Contract for which this document is issued.
3. The project mainly consists of:

**Deir Nbouh substation (AIS):**

- a) Relocation of one (1) power transformer bank 220/66kV (3 units) within same substation and make appropriate connections.
- b) Relocation of one (1) power transformer bank 220/150kV (3 units) within same substation and make appropriate connections.
- c) Relocation of 150 kV equipment from existing 150 kV transformer bay (TR1 220/150 kV) to new position.
- d) Convert two (2) existing AIS 220KV power transformer cells to 220KV overhead line cells (for new OHLs: Deir Amar - Deir Nbouh/double circuit overhead transmission line).
- e) Supply & Install two (2) AIS 220KV cells for the two (2) relocated power transformer banks (220/150 KV & 220/66KV).
- f) Convert part of the 150KV busbar to 220 KV busbar.
- g) Other works as per Tender document.

**Deir Amar substation (GIS):**

- a) Supply & install two (2) 220KV GIS cells for two (2) new overhead lines (new OHLs: Deir Amar-Deir Nbouh/double circuit).
- b) Other works as per Tender document.

The project covers survey, analysis, detailed design, removal and/or relocation of equipment, manufacturing of equipment and materials, factory testing, transport of equipment and materials, civil works, grounding system, measurement/protection and control system including SCADA equipment and requirements, plant construction, installation of equipment and materials, testing and commissioning, guaranty of works, spare parts, clearance of defects over the Defects Liability Period up to the issue of the final taking-over certificate, as deemed necessary to complete the Works.

The successful Bidder shall complete the Works within the period of time as defined in the Tender Documents.

**ELECTRICITE DU LIBAN (EDL)** and the legal successors in title to EDL will be the “Beneficiary” of the Works and will subsequently operate the power system facilities.

Payment shall be by a certified check from a local bank addressed to the Council for Development and Reconstruction. *Tender documents are free of charge for bidders who purchased them previously.*
6. Bids must include a Bid Security bank guaranty for a value of: 100,000 USD.

In addition, all Bids must be delivered to the above-mentioned office, **at or before 12:00 (noon) (Beirut local time) on Tuesday June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

7. A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Employer's address shown above (*date and time to be defined later*).
