AL GHADIR WASTEWATER COLLECTORS AND NETWORKS

GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

(Loan No. 84185)

The Lebanese Republic, through the Council for Development and Reconstruction (CDR) intends to launch a project consisting in the expansion and upgrade of the existing wastewater preliminary treatment plant located in Southern Beirut. The total cost of the project is EUR 146,500,000, and will be co-financed by own resources from the Government of Lebanon (EUR m 8.3), and in parallel co-financing with the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB, EUR 69.5) and the European Investment Bank (EIB, EUR m 68.5). The Project shall be implemented from 2019 to 2024.

The Project will improve sanitation for approximately 1 million inhabitants in the area south of Beirut and consists of the following works:

- 1) Extension and upgrade of the existing Al Ghadir waste water treatment plant, totally financed by IsDB;
- 2) Construction of sewer networks including house connections totally financed by EIB.

The components of the Project financed by the EIB may be summarized as follows:

1) Construction of Sewerage Networks including house connections:

- Construction of new sewerage networks with a total length of about 308km and about 19,000 house connections in the Ghadir drainage basin area.
- Connecting the existing conveyors and sewerage networks through which around 350 km of existing sewers will be connected to the Al Ghadir WWTP.

2) Engineering and supervision consultancy services:

Preparation of preliminary design, preparation of the detailed engineering design and the Tender documents, assist the CDR & PIU during Bids evaluation, and supervision of construction works.

3) Support for Project Implementation:

- Institutional capacity building and enhancement of industrial wastewater monitoring.
- Project Implementation Unit (PIU).

Procurement of contracts financed by the European Investment Bank (EIB) will be conducted through the procedures specified in the EIB's Guidelines: Guide to procurement for project financed by EIB, updated version of September 2018 and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the guidelines. Consulting services will be selected in accordance with the valid edition of the EIB's Guidelines.

Specific procurement notices for contracts bidding under the EIB's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures and for consultants' contracts will be announced, as they become available, in the [Official Journal of the European Union \(OJEU\)](#) and in local newspaper.

Prequalification of suppliers, contractors and consultants will be required for the project of the "Construction of Al Ghadir Sewer Collectors and Networks".
