Greater Beirut Water Supply Project Pipeline and Ancillaries

(Loan No. 7967 –LE; RFB No: BWW1 – A (RTW))

The Government of Lebanon has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of implementation of the Greater Beirut Water Supply Project (GBWSP). The Council for Development and Reconstruction (CDR), Project's implementing agency, intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Pipeline and Ancillaries.

The CDR now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the implementation of the Pipelines and Ancillaries remaining works, including implementation of about 3.5 km of twin 1400mm ND Ductile Iron Pipes and complete outstanding works in the installed section of the pipeline. The implementation period is estimated for 18 months.

Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's [*Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers*](#) (January 2011 revised on July 2014) (Procurement Guidelines) and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from CDR and inspect the Bidding document as of Tuesday April 20th, 2021 during office hours (from 8:00 to 13:00), Beirut local time at the address given below.

A complete set of the Bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of US\$ 250 (two hundred fifty United States Dollars) in the form of the banker's certified check in the name of the Council for Development and Reconstruction.

Bidders designated representatives are encouraged to attend the Pre-Bid meeting at the CDR offices on Wednesday May 5th, 2021 at 10:00AM, Beirut local time, at CDR premises, and the site visit guided by CDR on Tuesday May 4th, 2021, starting 10:00 AM, Beirut local time, from the meeting point at the existing site offices in Damour area.

Bids must be delivered in sealed envelopes, delivered to the address below on or before 12:00 o'clock noon, Beirut local time on **Thursday June 3rd, 2021** and be clearly marked "Bidding for Greater Beirut Water Supply Project - Construction of Pipeline and Ancillaries (BWW1 – A (RPW))". Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below at 12:00 o'clock noon on June 3rd, 2021.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of US\$ 500,000 (five hundred thousand United States Dollars).

All Bids must be accompanied by a Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) and/or Sexual Harassment (SH) Declaration.
